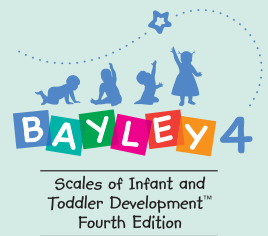


Bayley-4 Enhanced Administration Training Resource

Course Description

This fee-based online, independent study program provides detailed guidance for the administration and scoring of the Bayley Scales of Infant and Toddler Development™, Fourth Edition (Bayley-4). The program consists of six modules. Participants can earn a certificate of completion for each Bayley-4 module.

Description	Time Length
Module 1- General Information	
This module provides general information about the Bayley-4. Upon completion of the module, participants will describe the Bayley-4 scales and the general testing and administration guidelines for the Cognitive, Language, and Motor scales.	Approximately 50 minutes
Module 2 - Cognitive Scale	
This module describes administration and scoring of items on the Cognitive Scale of the Bayley-4. Upon completion of the module, participants will (1) describe the types of tasks the Bayley-4 uses to assess cognitive development of infants and toddlers, and (2) describe directions for administration and scoring of items from the Cognitive scale.	Approximately 90 minutes
Module 3 - Language Scale	
This module describes administration and scoring of items on the Language Scale of the Bayley-4. Upon completion of the module, participants will (1) describe the types of tasks the Bayley-4 uses to assess receptive and expressive language of infants and toddlers, and (2) describe directions for administration and scoring of items from the Language scale.	Approximately 90 minutes
Module 4 - Motor Scale	
This module describes administration and scoring of items on the Motor Scale of the Bayley-4. Upon completion of the module, participants will (1) describe the types of tasks the Bayley-4 uses to assess gross and fine motor skills of infants and toddlers, and (2) describe directions for administration and scoring of items from the Motor scale.	Approximately 90 minutes
Module 5 - Questionnaire	
This module describes administration and scoring of the Social-Emotional and Adaptive Behavior Questionnaire of the Bayley-4. Upon completion of the module, participants will (1) describe the types of items and subtests used to assess social-emotional development and adaptive behavior and (2) present instructions for administration and scoring of the Bayley-4 Questionnaire,	Approximately 40 minutes
Module 6 - Interpretation	
This module describes scores provided by the Bayley-4, associated descriptive classifications, and interpretation of the scores. Upon completion of the module, participants will (1) describe the types of scores provided by the Bayley-4 and (2) show how to use different scores to determine eligibility for early intervention services based on state eligibility criteria.	Approximately 40 minutes
