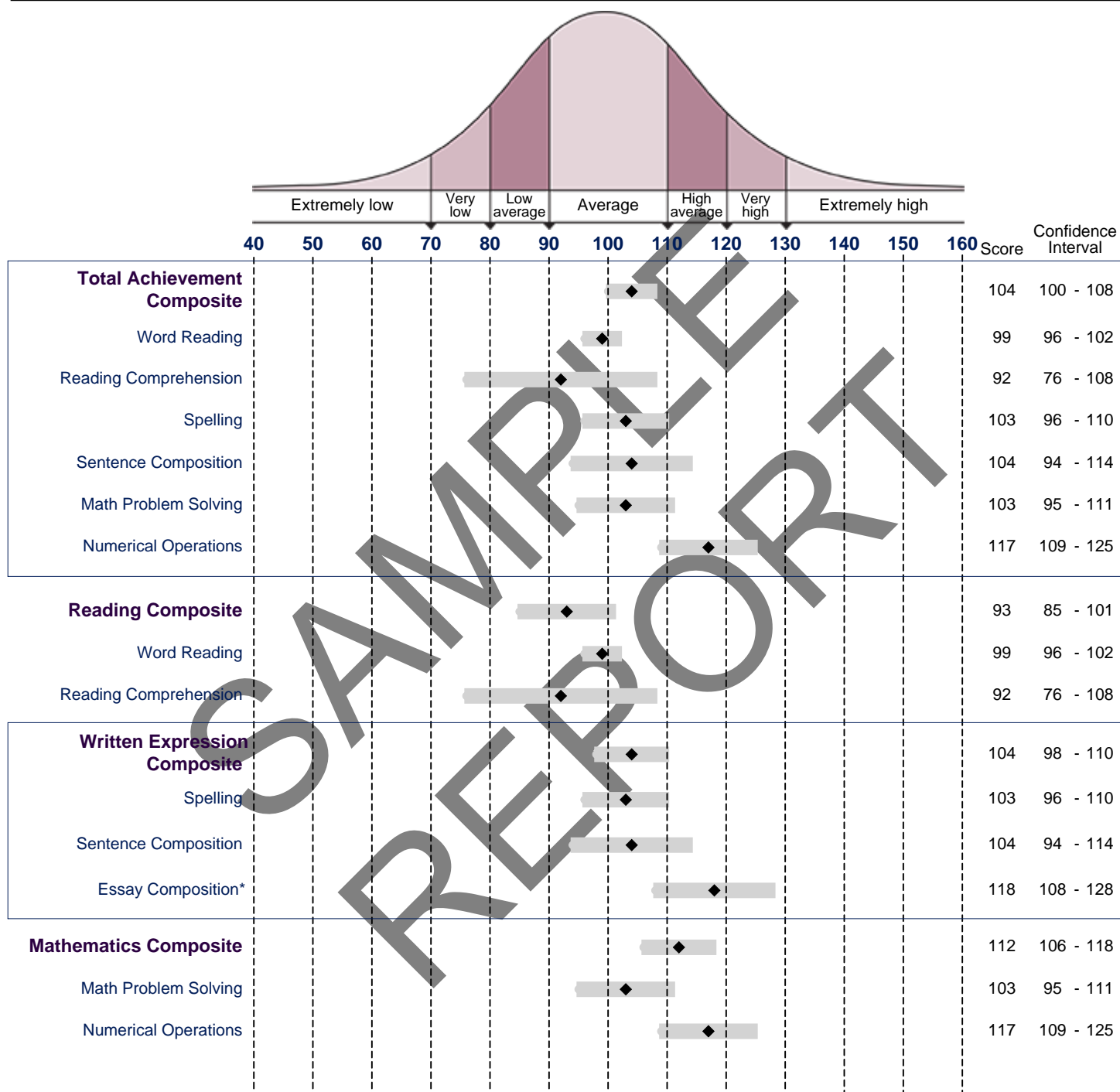

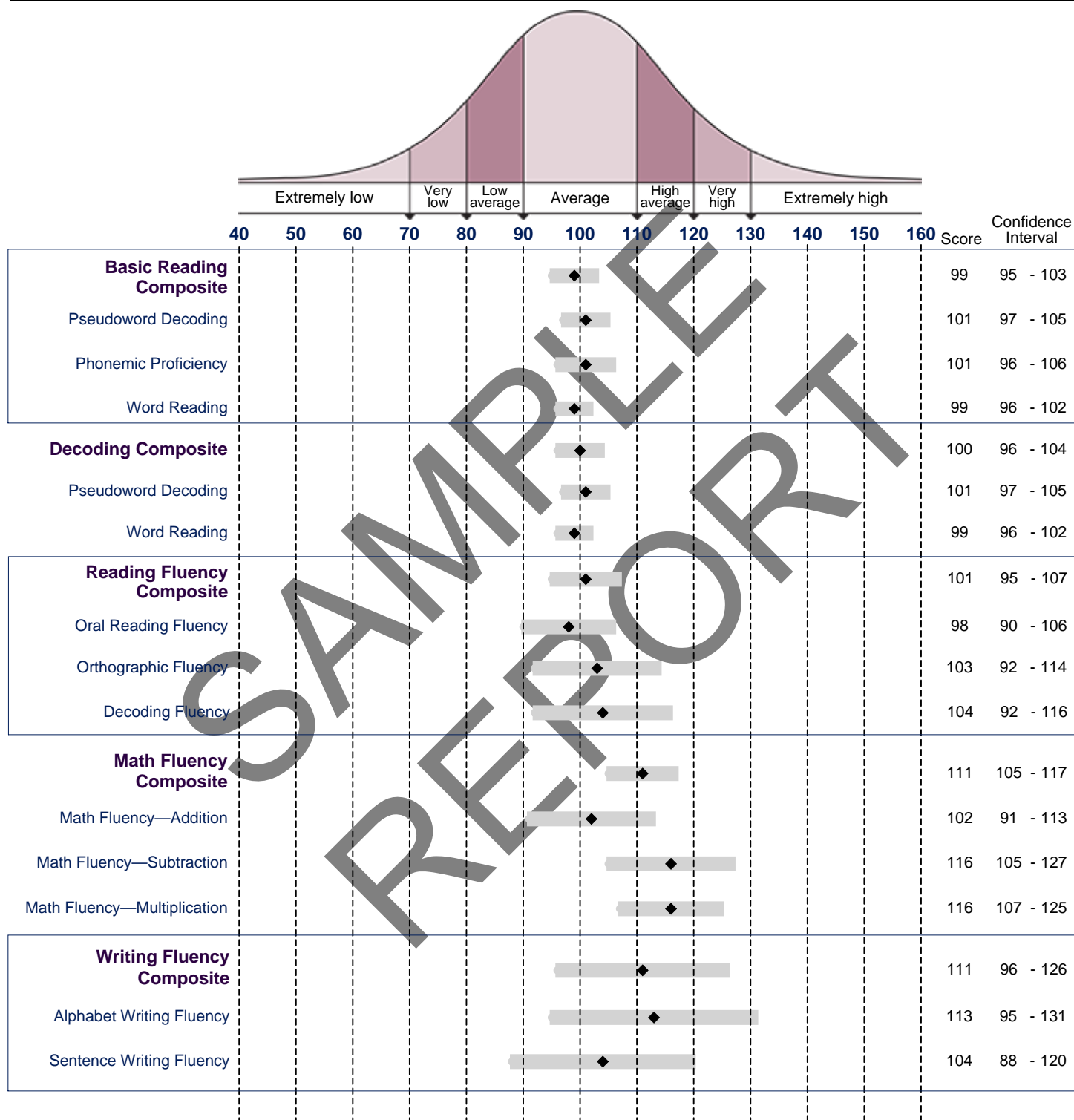

## Core Composite Score Summary Profile

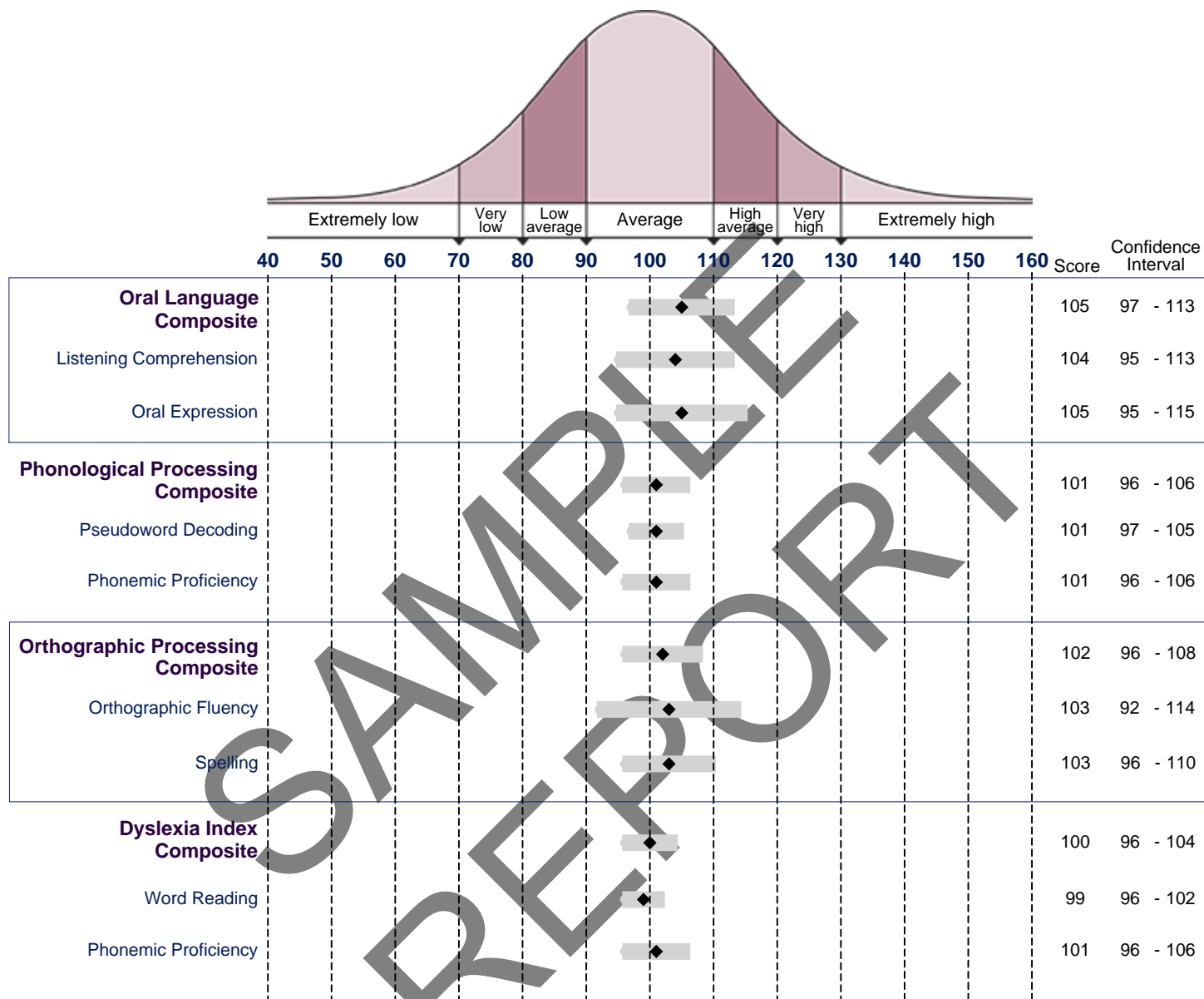

## Base Rates

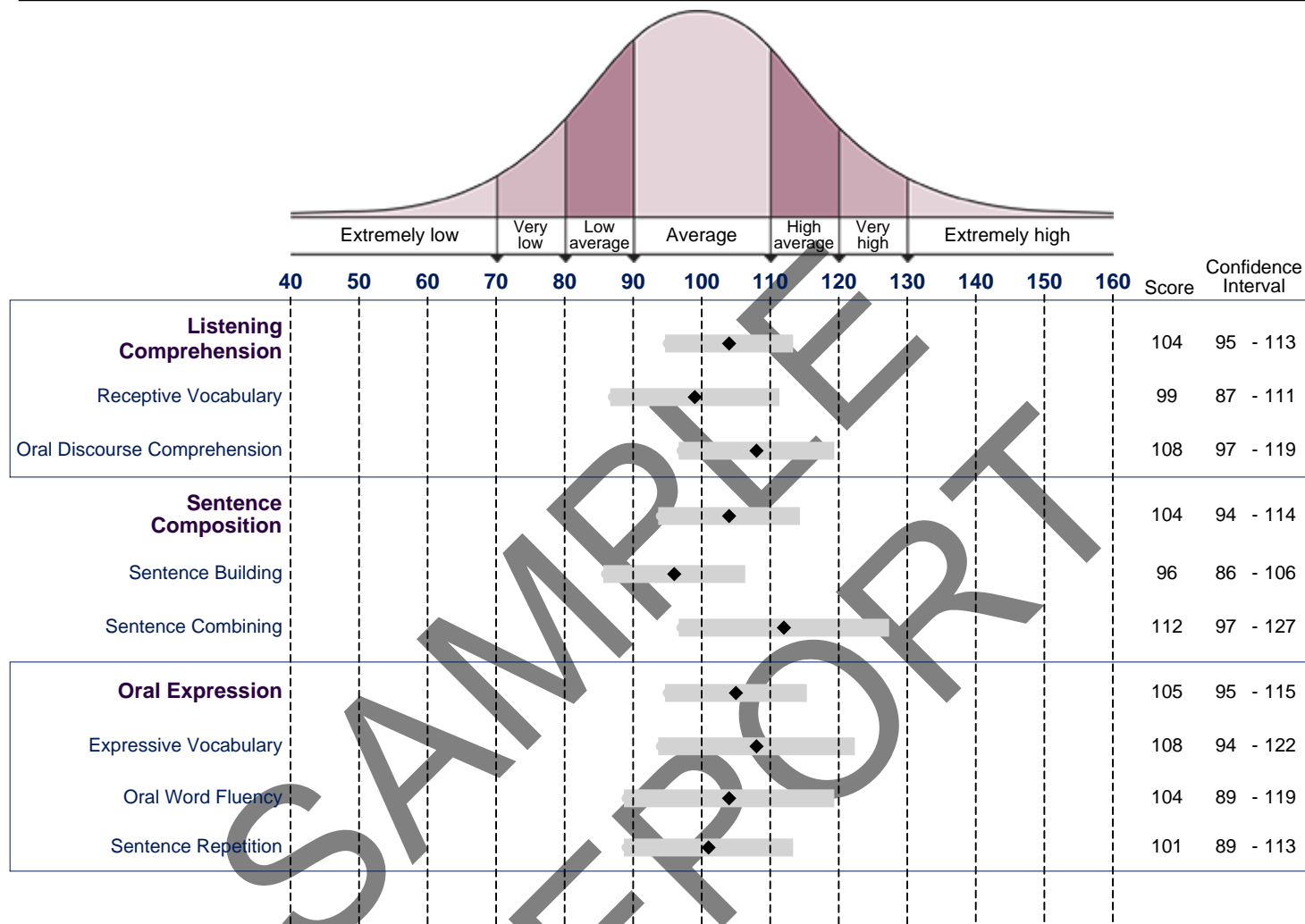
Oral Reading Accuracy	The number of errors made by the examinee on the Oral Reading Fluency passages was not unusual compared to individuals in the normative sample who took the same item set: >25% of the sample had the same number of errors or more, and 75% or less of the sample made fewer errors.
Oral Reading Rate	The examinee's reading rate on the Oral Reading Fluency passages was unusually slow compared to individuals in the normative sample who took the same item set: <=15% of the sample had the same or slower reading rate, and at least 85% of the sample had a faster reading rate.
