





Table 1. Specific Telepractice Considerations by EVT Subtest

Subtest	Considerations
Expressive Vocabulary	 Requires high-quality audio for examinee and examiner Examiner shows the visual stimuli and provides a verbal prompt Examinee views image onscreen and responds verbally Examiner provides a specific stimulus prompt if the examinee's response approximates/corresponds to the target response. For example, if the examinee says "luggages" rather than "luggage," the examiner provides the stimulus prompt of "give me a different form of that word." If the examinee's response is a phrase that includes the target word, then the examiner can score without asking the examinee to respond with only one word. For example, if the examinee responds with "a set of luggage" for the target <i>luggage</i>, the examiner can score the response as 1.
